

This kit contain



830 GR epoxy resin



Mold for tray + handles



5 colors of resin colorant



Gloves and mixing tools



Step-by-step guide

Step-by-step guide:

1. Lay down a plastic protective sheet to protect your work surface. Ensure that your silicone mold is clean and that all materials are within reach. Do not forget to wear disposable gloves.



2. Mix the epoxy resin according to the mixing ratio Art Pro 100:66 (by weight) – 180 g of component A and 119 g of component B – for a casting thickness of 5 mm. Weigh and mix both components carefully for 3 minutes, making sure to scrape all sides and the bottom of the mixing bowl well for a good mixing. Let the mixture rest for 2-3 minutes.



3. Divide the mixed resin into separate cups for each color you want to use. Add the colorants and mix well.



4. Layer the colors in a large bowl without mixing them, so they lie on top of each other. Pour these layers into your mold for a dynamic and abstract effect. Or pour each color into different spots in the mold, depending on your design.



5. After 24 hours, you can carefully remove your tray from the mold. After another 12 to 24 hours (when the resin is completely cured), make the tray functional by attaching the handles with the supplied screws. Drill holes in the tray and screw the handles tight.

More ideas! 

Geode effect

Use a layering technique with transparent, white, and colored resin to create a geode-like design. Start with transparent resin in the middle, alternate with white and colored layers, and finish with a final layer of transparent for depth.



More ideas

Ocean plateau: use different shades of blue and white with small shells or mini starfish for a beach feel.

Real dried flowers: incorporate real dried flowers or leaves into the resin for a natural look.

Gold leaf accents: add gold leaf or metallic foil for a luxurious touch.
