830 GR epoxy resin



6 square wooden coasters



6 round wooden coasters



9 resin colorants



Sanding sheet



Gloves and mixing tools



Step-by-step guide

Step-by-step guide

1. Lay down a plastic protective sheet to protect your work surface. Ensure that the wooden surface is clean and that all materials are within reach. Do not forget to wear disposable gloves.



2. Place your wooden coasters on cups or other objects. Check if the surface is level so that excess resin cannot run off the edges. This helps you create a neat resin artwork.



3. Mix the epoxy resin according to the **100:66 ratio (by weight)**: 42 g of A and 28 g of B to cover 2 round and 2 square coasters. Weigh and mix the components carefully for 3 minutes, scraping the sides and bottom of the mixing container well. Let the mixture rest for 2-3 minutes.



4. Divide the mixed resin into separate cups, one per color that you want to use. Add the resin colorant and mix well to get the desired shades.

5. Stack the colors in a large cup without mixing so that they layer on top of each other. Pour this in layers onto the wooden coasters for a dynamic and abstract effect. You can also pour each color separately onto different parts of the coasters, depending on your design idea.

6. Let the resin cure for **15 to 20 minutes to reduce air bubbles**. Use a small gas torch to gently go over the surface and burst any bubbles. Let your resin artwork cure dust-free for **24 to 48 hours**. After curing, use the sanding sheet to remove any excess resin that has run underneath the coasters.

More ideas

Wave patterns inspired by the ocean: Use blue-, turquoise-, and white-colored resin to make serene, flowing wave patterns. Add shells or small starfish for a beach vibe.

Galaxy: Create a cosmic artwork with deep purple, blue shades and shimmering glitter to mimic the vastness of space. Scatter small reflective pearls for a starry detail.

Elegant geode art: Reproduce the fascination of geodes by mixing various colors and metallic pigments for complex crystalline patterns.

Marble elegance: Make a luxurious marble effect with white, gray, and gold or rose gold resin. Swirl the colors to mimic the elegant veins of natural marble.

Lava flow: Use warm red-, orange-, and yellow tones to create the appearance of flowing lava.
